





Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the printed panel, cut:

(1) square 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide x 19" high with (1) large printed motif square centered in the panel.

From the brown yo yo print, cut:

- (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the binding.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" strips. Recut into (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 19" and (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 21 ¹/₂" pieces for the first (inner) border.

From the red apples print, cut:

(1) 2 ¹/₄" strip. Recut into (4) 2 ¹/₄" x 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the green plaid, cut:

(4) 4 ¹/₄" strips. Recut into (2) 4 ¹/₄" x 28 ³/₄" and (2) $4 \frac{1}{4}$ x 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ pieces for the third (outer) border.

From the blue dot, cut:

(1) 3" strip. Recut into (4) 3" x 3" squares. Recut each square on both diagonals to yield a total of (16) triangles.

From the yellow dot, cut:

- (1) 2 ⁵/₈" strip. Recut into (8) 2 ⁵/₈" x 2 ⁵/₈" squares. Recut each square on one diagonal to yield a total of (16) triangles.
- (4) 1 ³/₄" strips. Recut into (2) 1 ³/₄" x 24" and (2) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces for the second (middle) border.

From the green dot, cut:

(1) 2 ⁵/₈" strip. Recut into (8) 2 ⁵/₈" x 2 ⁵/₈" squares. Recut each square on one diagonal to yield a total of (16) triangles.

From the cream tonal, cut:

- (1) 3" strip. Recut into (4) 3" x 3" squares. Recut each square on both diagonals to yield a total of (16) triangles.
- (1) 2 ⁵/₈" strip. Recut into (8) 2 ⁵/₈" x 2 ⁵/₈" squares. Recut each square on one diagonal to yield a total of (16) triangles.

Sewing Instructions

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Stitch a 3" cream tonal triangle to a 3" blue dot triangle as shown. Sew this unit to the long side of a 2 5/8" green dot triangle as shown to make (1) block side unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) units.


OBLONG WALL HANGING



2. Stitch a 2 ⁵/₈" cream tonal triangle to a 2 ⁵/₈" yellow dot triangle long sides together to make (1) block corner unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) units.



3. Stitch block sides units to opposite sides of a 2 1/4" red apples print square, noting orientation. Sew block corner units to opposite sides of the remaining block side units, again noting orientation. Stitch these units to the remaining sides of the red apples print square to complete (1) block as shown. The finished size of the block should be $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{4}$ ".



4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make a total of (4) blocks.

Quilt Assembly

1. Stitch 1 ¹/₂" x 19" brown yo yo print strips to the left and right sides of the trimmed printed motif square. Sew

1 ¹/₂" x 21 ¹/₂" brown yo yo print strips to the top and bottom of the square.

2. Referring to the quilt pictured on the cover, sew the (4) pieced blocks together side by side to make a row. Stitch the block row to the bottom of the printed motif square unit.

3. Stitch 1 ³/₄" x 26 ¹/₄" yellow dot strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew 1 3/4" x 24" yellow dot strips to the top and bottom.

4. Stitch 4 ¹/₄" x 28 ³/₄" green plaid strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew 4 1/4" x 31 1/2" green plaid strips to the top and bottom.

5. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

6. Trim the finished quilt and bind using the 2 ¹/₂" brown yo yo print strips.

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the printed panel, cut:

(4) squares 9" wide x 9" high with (1) small printed motif square centered in each square.

From EACH of the blue yo yo print and the yellow dot, cut:

 (2) 5 ¹/₂" strips. Recut into (12) 5 ¹/₂" x 5 ¹/₂" squares. Cut each square in half on both diagonals to yield a total of (48) triangles.

From the red mosaic print, cut:

(2) 6 ¹/₂" strips. Recut into (12) 6 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" squares.

(6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the binding.

From the red apples print, cut:

(3) 2 ⁵/₈" strips. Recut into (18) 2 ⁵/₈" x 4 ³/₄" pieces.

From the green dot, cut:

(3) 2 ⁵/₈" strips. Recut into (18) 2 ⁵/₈" x 4 ³/₄" pieces.

(5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the inner border.

From the cream animal print, cut:

(6) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the outer border.


From the cream tonal, cut:

(10) 2⁵/₈" strips. Recut into (36) 2 ⁵/₈" x 4 ³/₄" pieces and (72) 2 ⁵/₈" x 2 ⁵/₈" squares.

Sewing Instructions

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Stitch a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blue yo yo print triangle to a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow dot triangle. Sew the triangle unit to one side of a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " red mosaic print square, matching the center point of the square to the seam joining the triangles. Repeat for each side of the red mosaic print square to complete (1) block measuring 9" from raw edge to raw edge in both directions. Repeat to make a total of (12) blocks.




SQUARE WALL HANGING

2. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong sides of (2) 25% cream tonal squares. Layer a marked square on one end of a 25% x 43% red apples print piece, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam line and press the resulting cream triangle up. Repeat for the opposite end of the red apples print piece to make one flying geese unit as shown. Repeat to make a second red apples flying geese unit. Repeat this procedure to make (2) green dot flying geese units using 25%" cream tonal squares and 25%" x 43%" green dot pieces.



3. Sew a $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ " cream tonal piece to the top of each flying geese unit from step 2. Arrange these units into (2) rows with (2) units in each row, noting orientation and fabric placement. Stitch the units together to complete (1) block measuring 9" x 9" from raw edge to raw edge in both directions.



4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make a total of (9) blocks. **Quilt Assembly**

1. Referring to the quilt pictured on the cover, arrange the blocks into (5) rows with (5) blocks in each row. Alternate the two types of blocks and the trimmed printed motif squares as shown. Stitch the blocks into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

2. Trim the selvages from the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}''$ green dot strips. Sew the strips together end to end to make a long $2\frac{1}{2}''$ strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 47" and (2) 43" lengths *(if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top)*. Sew the shorter pieces to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the longer pieces to the top and bottom.

3. Trim the selvages from the 5 ¹/₂" cream animal print strips. Sew the strips together end to end to make a long 5 ¹/₂" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 57" and (2) 47" lengths *(if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top)*. Sew the shorter pieces to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the longer pieces to the top and bottom.

4. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

5. Trim the finished quilt and bind using the 2 ½" red mosaic print strips. ©2011 Henry Glass & Co.
