Cutting Instructions:

From the **CREAM** fabric, cut:

8 - 4" x 42" strips. Cut into 80 - 4" squares

From the **BLACK** fabric, cut:

6 - 2 ½" x 42" strips. Cut into 80 -2 ½" squares

From the **TURQOISE INNER BORDER** fabric, cut:

5 - 4" x 42" strips and cut into 14 - 4" x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " and 4 - 4" squares

From the **BROWN FLORAL BORDER** fabric, cut:

6 - 7" x 42" strips

From the **STRIPE BINDING** fabric, cut:

3 ½" wide strips cut on the bias, totaling 280" in length when sewn together.

For the **BLOCKS** cut the following from each fat quarter: Refer to the diagram for placement:

A. $2-2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ "

B. $2-2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9"

C. $2-1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9"

D. $2-1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6 ½"

E. 4 - 3" squares


F. 4- 2 1/4" squares

G. 6 ½" square

12 - fat quarter for blocks Cream: 1 yard for folded corners Black: 7/8 yard for folded corners Turquoise Dot: ³/₄ yard for inner border

Fabric Requirements:

Brown Floral: 1 1/3 yards for outer border Binding: 7/8 yard of brown stripe Backing and batting: 64" x 77"



Assembly Instructions:


1. Draw a diagonal line across the backside of all of the 2 1/4" squares. Lay one of the 2 1/4" squares right sides together with the 6 ½" center square. Sew of the drawn line and trim off the outer corner, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. This is called the Folded Corner technique. Repeat on the other 3 corners of the center square. Press the seams away from the center square. Border the center square with the 1 ³/₄" wide pieces, using matching fabric as shown. Again, press the seams away from the center squares. Repeat to make a total of 12 blocks.

















2. Repeat Step 1 as shown, this time using the 3" squares and the 2 3/4" wide pices. The blocks should measure 13 1/2" x 13 ½"








3. Using the folded corner technique, sew the cream 4" squares to the block as shown. Press as directed by arrows. Add black 2 ½" folded corners as shown, press the seams in the same direction as the cream squares.





4. Using the folded corner technique, sew the remaining cream 4" squares to the turquoise 4" x 13 ½" and 4" squares as shown. Press as directed by arrows. Add the black folded corners and press in the same direction as the cream folded corners. Sew these units together as shown below.



Make 8 for the side borders of the quilt





Make 6 for the top and bottom borders of the quilt

Add black folded corners to all units, Pressing in the same direction as the cream



Make 2 of each for corners of the quilt

- 5. Sew the quilt together into rows. (I pressed these seams open). Be sure to turn the blocks so all the seams nest (as shown by arrows). Sew the rows together. The quilt should now measures 39 ½" x 52 ½". Sew the turqoise border sections for the sides of the quilt together and add to the quilt (again, all these seams should nest). Repeat with the top and bottom border sections, this time adding the corner blocks as shown. The quilt should now measure 46 ½" x 59 ½".
- 6. Sew all of the brown floral border strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths for the sides of the quilt. (actual measurement is 59 ½", but measure your own quilt to determine your length). Sew to the quilt and press the seams toward the blue. Cut off two lenths for the top and bottom of the quilt (this measurement is also 59 ½", but again measure your own quilt first). Sew to the quilt and press the seams toward the blue.
- 7. Bind using the cream stripe fabric strips.
