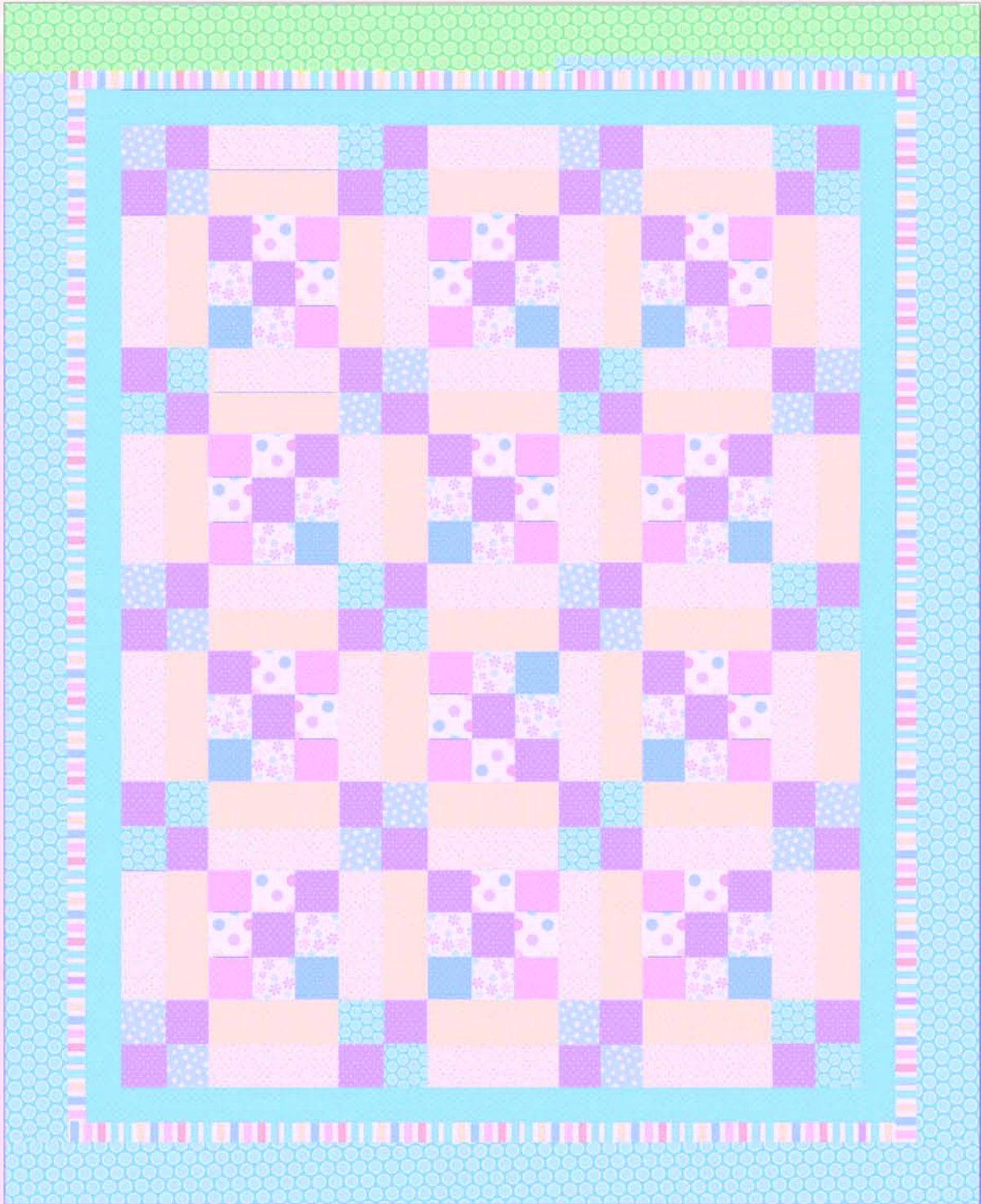

EASY QUILT!



 WINDHAM FABRICS

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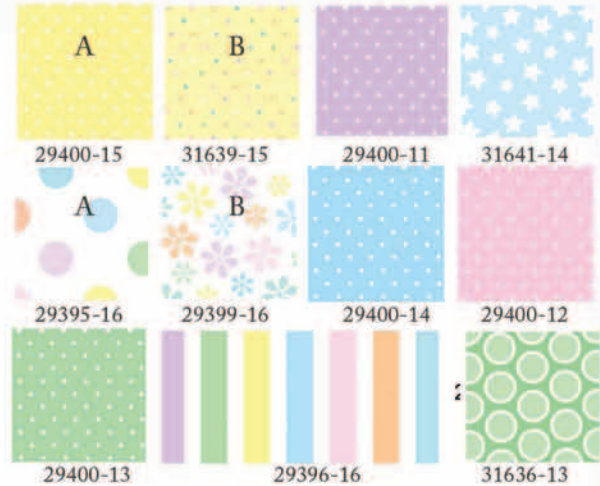
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Size: 45" X 55"

Twelve 6" 9-Patch Blocks,
Twenty 4" 4-Patch Blocks
Skill Level: Beginner

Materials

- 1/2 yard yellow A (29400-15)
- 1/2 yard yellow B (31639-15)
- 1/2 yard lilac (29400-11)
- 1/4 yard blue for 4-patch (31641-14)
- 1/4 yard light print A (29395-16)
- 1/4 yard light print B (29399-16)
- 1/4 yard blue for 9-patch (29400-14)
- 1/4 yard pink (29400-12)
- 1 yard green for inner border and binding (29400-13)
- 1/3 yard striped print for middle border (29396-16)
- 1 yard green for outer border and 4-patch (31636-13)
- 2 3/4 yard backing
- 50" X 60" piece of batting



Cutting Directions

- From each of the yellow fabrics A and B cut: Thirty-one 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- From the lilac cut: Sixty-four 2 1/2" squares
- From the blue 4-patch fabric cut: Twenty 2 1/2" squares
- From each of the light prints A and B and the pink cut: Twenty-four 2 1/2" squares
- From the blue 9-patch fabric cut: Twelve 2 1/2" squares
- From the green inner border fabric cut: Five 2" x WOF strips, five 2 1/2" x WOF strips
- From the striped fabric cut: Five 1 1/2" x WOF strips
- From the green outer border fabric cut: Five 3 1/2" x WOF strips, twenty 2 1/2" squares for 4-patch blocks

4-Patch Blocks

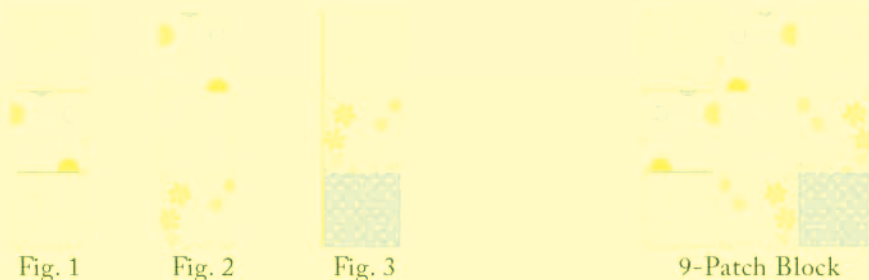
- Sew two lilac squares to two blue squares. Sew these two segments together to obtain a 4-patch block. Make ten lilac/blue 4-patch blocks.



- Sew two lilac squares to two green squares. Sew these two segments together to obtain a 4-patch block. Make ten lilac/green 4-patch blocks.

9-Patch Blocks

- Sew a pink square to opposite sides of a light A square. (Fig. 1) Sew a light A square and a light B square to opposite sides of a lilac square. (Fig. 2) Sew a lilac square and a blue square to opposite sides of a light B square. (Fig. 3) Sew these three rows together as shown in the diagram. Make twelve 9-patch blocks.

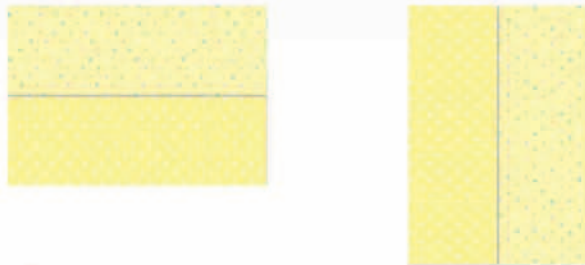


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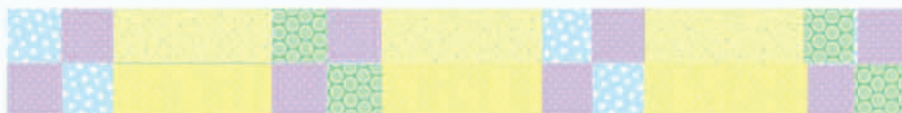
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Assemble the Quilt

- Sew each of the yellow A strips to a yellow B strip along the long side to make thirty-one sashing units.



- Follow the quilt layout diagram to lay out the sashing units and blocks for each row. For odd rows use two lilac/blue 4-patch blocks, two lilac/green 4-patch blocks and three sashing units. For even rows use three 9-patch blocks and four sashing units. Sew together the blocks and sashing units in each row. Sew together the rows.

Even Row

- Cut two of the 2” wide green strips 34 ½” long and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt. Piece two 47 ½” x 2” green strips and sew these to the sides of the quilt.
- Cut two of the 1 ½” wide striped strips 37 ½” long and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt. Piece two 49 ½” x 1 ½” striped strips and sew these to the sides of the quilt.
- Cut two of the 3 ½” wide outer border green strips 39 ½” long and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt. Piece two 55 ½” x 3 ½” outer border green strips and sew these to the sides of the quilt.
- Layer the backing batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired.
- Use the 2 ½” green strips to bind the quilt.
