E. Pattern #20846 – SAG1 ^{1/2} yard
F. Pattern #20846 – BLA1 17/8 yards
(includes binding)
G. Pattern #20847 – BLA1 1 yard
H. Pattern #20848 – BLA1 1 yard

K. Pattern #12615 – BLA1 5 yards

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. ¹/4" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Cut fabrics in order given.

- A. Pattern #20842 BLA1 (panel):
 - 1. Trim panel to measure 22¹/₂" x 42¹/₂" centering design.
- B. Pattern #20844 BLA1 (border stripe):
 - 1. Cut four 7" x length of fabric strips for outer border, centering design as shown in quilt photo.
- C. Pattern #20845 GRE/GOL1 (stripes): 1. Cut six 1¹/₂" strips.
- D. Pattern #20845 BLA/ROS1 (stripes):
 - 1. Cut two 1¹/₂" strips; subcut each to 1¹/₂" x 28¹/₂".
- E. Pattern #20846 SAG1 (leaves):
 - 1. Cut four $3^{1}/_{2}$ " strips; subcut each to $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $28^{1}/_{2}$ ".
- F. Pattern #20846 BLA1 (leaves):
 - 1. Cut eleven 31/2" strips.
 - 2. Cut nine $2^{1}/_{2}$ " strips for binding.
- G. Pattern #20847 BLA1 (bird medallions):
 1. Fussy cut twelve 6³/₈" squares centering medallion within each one.
- H. Pattern #20848 BLA1 (butterflies):
 - 1. Cut four 7¹/₂" strips; subcut two 7¹/₂" x 36¹/₂" and two 7¹/₂" x 42¹/₂".
- I. Pattern #20849 DKPIN1 (tonal print):
 - 1. Cut seven $1^{1}/_{2}$ " strips; subcut sixteen $1^{1}/_{2}$ " x $6^{3}/_{8}$ " and $1^{1}/_{2}$ " x $8^{3}/_{8}$ ".
- J. Pattern #20849 LTPIN1 (tonal print):
 - 1. Cut four 11/2" strips; subcut eight 11/2" x 63/8" and 11/2" x 83/8".



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
PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:


A. Framed blocks:


- 1. Sew one 1¹/₂" x 6³/₈" [I] strip to each side of the 6³/₈" [G] medallion square. Press seams to square (Figure 1).
- 2. Sew one 1¹/₂" x 8³/₈" [I] strip to the top and bottom of the block; press (Figure 1). Repeat to make eight blocks.
- 3. Repeat using [J] strips to make four blocks.
- 4. Trim all the blocks to 71/2".
- B. Green pieced border:
 - 1. Sew one $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $28^{1}/_{2}$ " [E] strip to each side of a $1^{1}/_{2}$ " x $28^{1}/_{2}$ " [D] strip. Press seams toward green leaf fabric. Repeat (Figure 2).

C. Black pieced border:

- 1. Sew the $3^{1}/_{2}$ " [F] strips together end to end; press. Cut four $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $50^{1}/_{2}$ " strips for top and bottom borders and four $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $56^{1}/_{2}$ " strips for side borders.
- 2. Sew the six 1¹/₂" [*C*] strips end to end; press. Cut two 1¹/₂" x 50¹/₂" strips and two 1¹/₂" x 56¹/₂" strips.
- 3. For top and bottom borders, sew one 3¹/₂" x 50¹/₂" [F] strip to each side of a 1¹/₂" x 50¹/₂" [C] strip. Press seam to black leaf fabric (Figure 3). Repeat.
- For side borders, sew one 3¹/₂" x 56¹/₂" [F] strip to each side of a 1¹/₂" x 56¹/₂"
 [C] strip. Press toward the black leaf fabric. (Figure 3). Repeat.










QUILT ASSEMBLY: (Refer to Quilt Diagram)

- 1. Sew a dark pink framed block to each end of both green pieced borders. Blocks are directional so position them correctly. Press toward the borders. Sew one border set to each side of panel [A].
- 2. Sew a 7¹/₂" x 42¹/₂" [H] border strip to both sides of quilt center. Press toward H. Sew a light pink framed block to each end of both 7¹/₂" x 36¹/₂" [H] border strips. Blocks are directional so position them correctly. Press toward the borders. Sew one border set to top and bottom of quilt center; press.
- 3. Sew a 56¹/₂" black pieced border to both sides of quilt. Press toward the pieced borders. Sew a dark pink framed block to each end of both 50¹/₂" black pieced border. Blocks are directional so position them correctly. Press toward the borders. Sew one border set to top and bottom of quilt center; press.
- 4. Match and pin the middle of a border [B] strip to the center of a side of the quilt. Sew to quilt beginning and ending a generous ¹/4" from both ends of the quilt. Repeat for all four [B] borders. Close corners of borders with mitered seams. Trim seam allowance and press seams open.

FINISHING:

- Prepare backing with a horizontal seam to measure 85" x 91". Press seam open.
- Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim the batting and backing even with quilt top.
- Prepare binding using 2¹/₂" [F] strips. Sew to quilt using your perferred method.
